Session 1	<p>What is belonging?</p> <p>Where do you feel like you belong?</p>	<p>Belonging is a sense of fitting in or feeling like you are an important member of a group.</p>
Session 2	<p>Why do Muslim's pray at Mosque?</p> <p>What things can you do as part of a group?</p>	<p>A prayer done in congregation is highly encouraged in Islam. In fact, the reward is 25 times more than a prayer offered alone.</p>
Session 3	<p>What is a ritual?</p> <p>What rituals do Muslims do before they pray?</p>	<p>A religious ceremony consisting of a series of actions performed in a prescribed order.</p> <p>Before prayers, Muslims are expected to perform a purification ritual called Wudu, requiring that they wash their faces, hands, arms, and feet.</p>
Session 4	<p>What is Hajj?</p> <p>How many prayers is praying at mosque equivalent to compared to praying at home?</p>	<p>Hajj is a pilgrimage made to the Kaaba, the "House of God ", in the sacred city of Mecca. It is one of the 5 pillars of Islam.</p> <p>25 times.</p>
Session 5	<p>What is community?</p> <p>Does going to a Mosque give Muslim's a sense of belonging?</p>	<p>A group of people living in the same place or having something in common.</p> <p><i>*Children will give their perspective on the key question.</i></p>

Key vocabulary	
Allah	The one and only God in Islam.
Islam	A religion teaching that Muhammad is a messenger of God. Followers of the religion are known as Muslims.
Mosque	A Mosque is a place of worship for Muslims.
Muslim	Muslims are people that follow or practice Islam.
Prophet	A person who is regarded as being in contact with God and is said to speak on behalf of them.
Quran	The Islamic sacred book.
