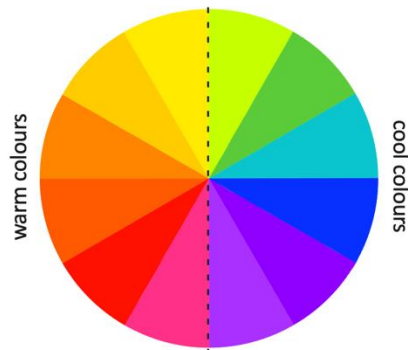


KS1 Knowledge Organiser Art - Painting

Effects	An effect is the way that a user can apply paint to an image to achieve a specific artistic look.
Mixing	To combine/put together more than one colour to create a new colour (usually primary colours to make secondary colours)
Wet technique	Painting directly on top of wet paint without allowing the lower layer to dry.
Dry technique	A painting technique in which a paint brush that is relatively dry , but still holds paint, is used.
Backgrounds	A background is the space that surrounds your painting.
Mood	Mood is the atmosphere in a painting, or the feeling expressed.
