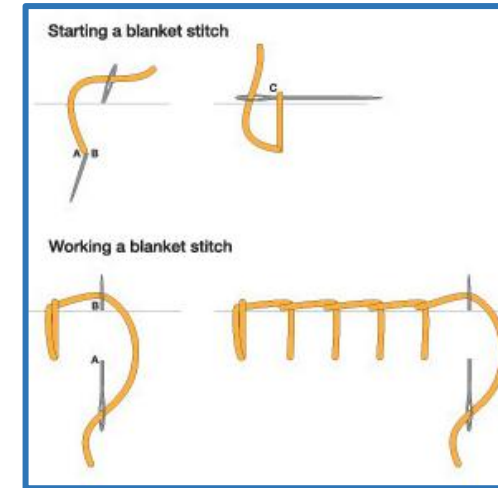
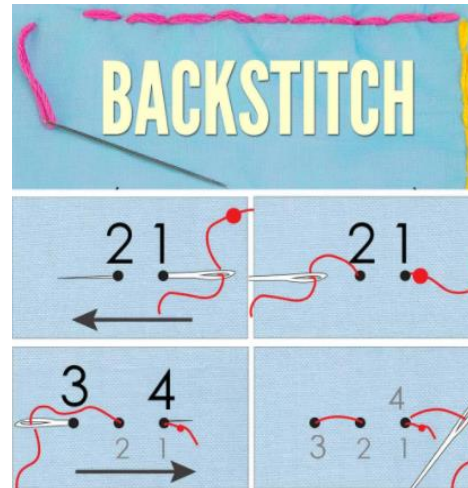

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Functional properties	The ways in which the product is used how practical and useful it is
Aesthetic qualities	The overall visual effect of the product, so how it looks, feels.
Measure	To measure with a ruler or appropriate measuring device the length of something.
Back stitch	a stitch sewn one stitch length backward on the front side and two stitch lengths forward on the reverse side to form a solid line of stitching on both sides
Blanket stitch	a buttonhole stitch used on the edges of a blanket or other material too thick to be hemmed.
Design specification	A Product design specification is a detailed document providing information about a designed product or process.
Purposeful	Having a useful and practical purpose
Evaluate	To be able to comment on a design in terms of how it looks and how useful it is does it fit the criteria etc.
Appealing	How interesting it looks, colourful, and attractive. Etc.
Textiles	A type of cloth or woven fabric
Generate	To produce or create example when you generate ideas.
