Vocabulary	Definition
Relationships	The way in which two or more people or things are connected, or the state of being connected.
Emotions	The range of feelings you have that you can show in different ways
Grief	Intense sadness you feel.
Distant	When something or somebody is far away
Special	When something is better, greater, or otherwise different from what is usual.
Remember	Have in or be able to bring to one's mind an awareness of (someone or something from the past).
Opinion	Express your own view and give your own reasons for doing something
