What is the course about?

The way Maths is taught in primary schools has changed. There are now many different ways to tackle Maths problems. **Maths-busters** is a 6-week course that will support parents struggling to help their children with their Maths homework.

Parents will be in a small, supportive class that will provide them with information, advice and guidance to continue after the course.

Eligibility

Parents/carers need to be 19 or older and have not achieved grade C (4) or above in Maths or Functional Skills Level 2.

What can people do after the course?

This course is an excellent way for people to **Get Started** on their **Maths** journey. They may wish to continue to study in order to gain their own qualifications. Or, if they found supporting their children to be particularly interesting they might like to explore becoming a teaching assistant and look into the **Early Year's** courses.

As **Maths-Busters** is a short course, parents may have found being around other adults helpful and might like support to start up their own community group.
