

Introduction the beginning of a song. Usually musical.

Melody is a sequence of notes that sounds nice.

Rhythm is when long and short sounds are put together. They create a strong and regular repeated sound and pattern.

Structure in songs



In **pop music**, songs often follow a **verse** - **chorus** - **verse structure**.

Verses usually come before a chorus. They often repeat but with different lyrics for each verse.

The **chorus** is usually a catchy section repeated throughout the song. Every time we get to the **chorus**, typically the **lyrics** are the same making it easy to sing along to.
