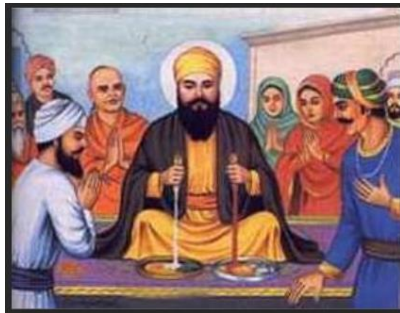


WORD	DEFINITION

Spring 1: Beliefs and Moral Values

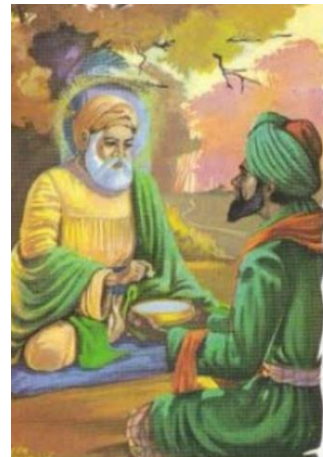
What makes things special?
